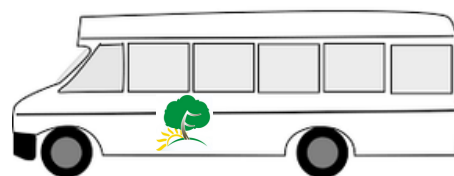

- Snow is here, please remember to park inside your garage when possible and off the roads when snow is expected. Avoid street parking. You are permitted to park your extra vehicle in the big parking lot between the Community Building and the Care Center.
- If you plan to travel for an extended time, please stop at Wyse Commons and fill out a leave form. While you are away we watch over your home with extra care and make sure that everything is taken care of so you can enjoy your trip with peace of mind.
- Remember to drive slowly through campus. Speed Limit is 15 MPH.
- Staff shovels sidewalks in the following order of priority. Care Center-to ensure staff can get into the building to care for the residents as well as safe entrance for EMT. USDA Sidewalks-as this is their only means of exiting their home. Duplex Homes/Wyse Commons/Haven Apartments.

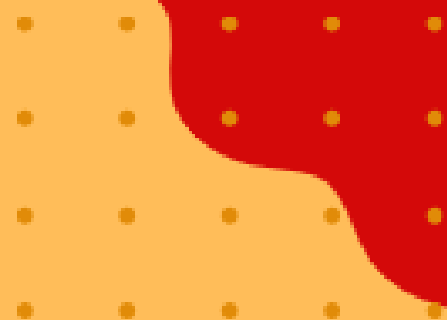
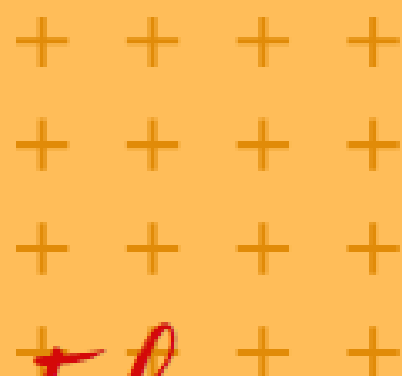
