

Purpose: The purpose of this research is measuring predictors of Senior Center utilization and perception of existing Senior Center programs. Additionally, the project aims to redefine aging and what community-based aging services should look like.

Eligibility Criteria: individuals age 60+ who have/have not participated in a Senior Center program or service within the past three months.

Time Commitment In Person Focus Group: 90 Minutes

Time Commitment online or paper survey: 15 Minutes

Location: Online or in Person at Fairlawn

Incentives: In person focus group on July 29th will receive a FREE lunch and a \$25 gift card! Online & Paper Survey; after completing the survey, you will have the opportunity to enter your name and contact information in order to be entered into a drawing for the raffle of one physical \$50 Walmart gift card. There will be 20 total drawings between July and August, 2025. Drawings will occur approximately once per week during the data collection period. You will have a 1 in 25 chance, or a 4% chance of winning a gift card.


