COVID INFORMATION

- DO NOT park on the roadways. If you do not have a garage or driveway, park in a designated parking space.
- Please be patient! Our maintenance team is working to get all areas cleared as soon as possible. If you have an urgent need, and your drive or entrance has not been cleared, call the emergency Maintenance line at 419.551.2838.
- If we lose power and you have life sustaining medical equipment that needs power access, you are invited to use Fairlawn Haven Care Center where there are outlets connected to a generator.

ONE DAY PARKING ONLY ON ROADWAYS

- Overnight parking is NOT permitted on Fairlawn Roadways. Any resident or guest that cannot park in a driveway should find a public parking area on the Fairlawn campus (please note: spaces around Fairlawn Apartments are numbered and reserved for apartment resident use only). Our roads are narrow and roadway parking makes it challenging for emergency vehicles and dangerous for pedestrians. Please protect yourself and your guests. Thank you for your cooperation.
