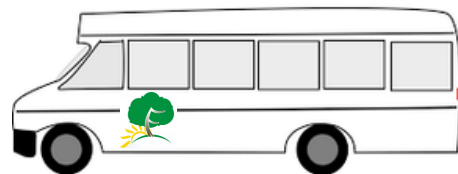

These fee-based services are to provide you with additional support within your home. With a wide variety of services available to you, we are ready to meet your needs and lend a helping hand.

SERVICES & PRICING:

Medication Box set up:

- Once a week medication box restocking
- **\$30/week**

Medication reminders:

- we all forget things now and then, let us remind you to take those medications
- **\$40/month**

Blood Pressure/Vital Sign

Check:

- As needed blood pressure and vital signs checked
- **\$15-\$30**

Housekeeping:

- light house cleaning, such as sweeping, moping, bathroom cleaning, dishes
- **\$25/hour**

Linen and Laundry Services:

- Bedding changes, laundry washing and folding
- **\$25/hour**

Meals:

- **\$6 per meal/**includes delivery if requested

Errands:

- Pricing varies per errand
