It's rare for such a large community to be blessed so abundantly; but Fairlawn has it and my time here will forever be cherished.

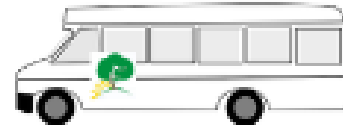

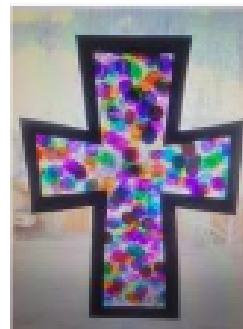

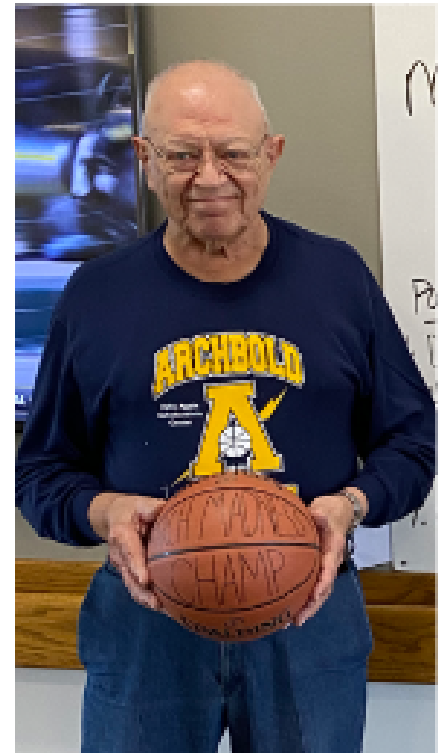

This resident-led group would be hosted by Jan Roloff. It's a great opportunity to keep up your passion for stitching, or perhaps re-ignite that flame.

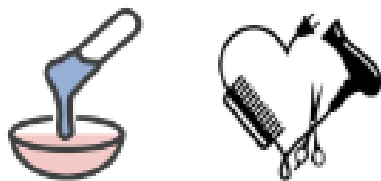

Winner gets a SuperValu gift card.

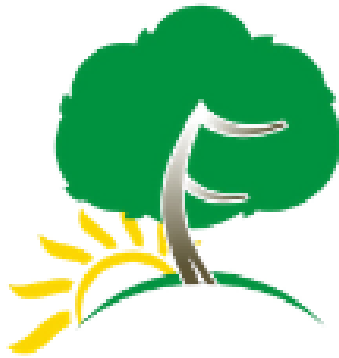
Following the judging and announcement of the winner, all are welcome to sample the fabulous variety of chilis!
