Hockey Game

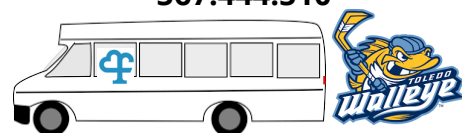

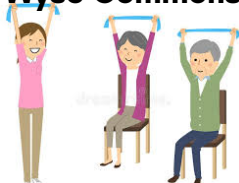

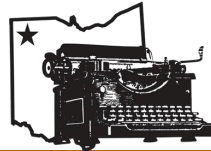

Fulton County residents continue to band together to donate time, money, and gifts to help families in need during the holiday season. Fairlawn is pleased to be a partner with Christmas Cheer by serving as a drop off location for food, gifts, and other needed items. On November 3rd, the annual Christmas Cheer Tree in Wyse Commons will be filled with ornament tags that list items

needed to make this year's Christmas Cheer a success. Please stop by and select a tag (or a couple tags!) of items you would like to donate. All items must be dropped off at Wyse Commons by December 8th to be transported to the Fairgrounds to be sorted and stocked. Christmas Cheer will be open on Dec. 10-11 for families that have registered. We hope you can join us as we work to support families in need!

Help Feed the Kids

The "Snack Sisters", is a group within the nonprofit Shepperd Circle, and they are hoping to partner with the residents of Fairlawn to help feed the students of the local IEC school. The IEC school has children going home for the weekend with not enough or, in some cases, any food for the weekend.

The Independence Education Center (IEC) is a self-contained building for students at the K-12 level who require intensive behavioral support to meet their educational goals. The school serves many of the local schools in northwest Ohio, including the Bryan school district.

This school year, they have fifty-plus students registered. The goal is to provide a "snack pack" available to every student who wishes to take one home on Fridays.

If you would like to help feed these children, the way you can help is by donating items for the snack pack or a monetary donation for "Snack Sisters" to buy items. A donation box will be at Wyse Commons with the listed items posted on it.

Items needed: Trail mix, Pop-Tarts, Oatmeal pies, Breakfast bars, Peanut butter crackers, Beef sticks that do NOT need refrigeration, Cheese sticks that do NOT need refrigeration and Individual microwavable mac n cheese.




