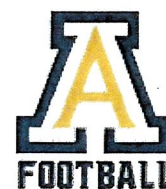


Welcome, Zandra! Independent Living's New Housekeeper

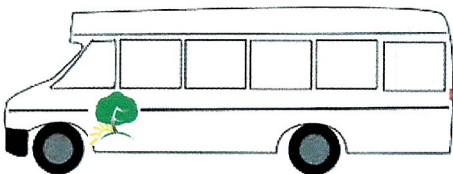

More information is coming as the new programs roll out over the next several months, and we will need some flexibility; but we are really excited about the future and we thank you all in advance for your patience as we work through the process.

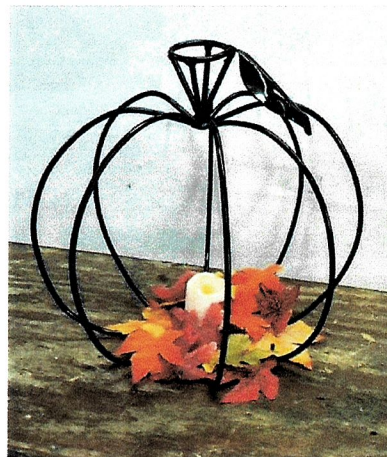

Signs cannot be placed in grass, landscape areas away from the house, near the road or in public areas.

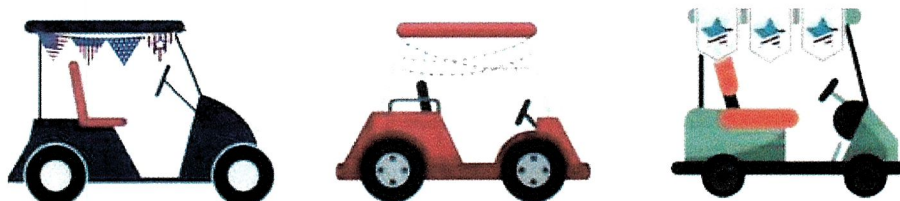
Halloween Themed Golf Cart Parade Thursday October 14th
