Fall Landscape Update



Fall Landscape Trimming

Expect Custom Turf Solutions to begin trimming landscapes mid to late October. This trimming will be light, Rose of Sharon and Rose Bushes will be trimmed this round. Be sure to get a sign out if you do not want certain shrubs or landscape beds trimmed.

Spider & Ant Prevention

In mid October, Custom Turf will apply pesticide around each home on campus to prevent spiders and other insects from seeking shelter in your homes this fall and winter.



Stone Replacement Project

Things to know as you see some of your neighbors transitioning from Mulch to Stone:

- The oldest lease agreements on campus are being offered the opportunity to make the switch first.
- You may decline stone and keep mulch.
- The switch to stone will not cost you, the resident, anything.
- Black edging will be removed, also, and replaced with a block edge.
- Fairlawn will still purchase mulch each year for those wanting to freshen up an area here or there. However, semi loads of mulch will no longer be brought in each spring.
