# WHY IS IT TAKING SO LONG?

Although many of the daily limitations of COVID are gone, Fairlawn, along with the rest of the country, is experiencing supply shortages of basic items needed to do home and appliance repairs. We are struggling to find building materials and supplies and when we do, the price has increased significantly. Our maintenance team is doing all they can to make sure that you are taken care of. Sometimes this means we can only perform a temporary repair until needed parts are available.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as Fairlawn works to find repair parts, new appliances, floor coverings and other materials needed each time we prepare for someone new to join our campus or work to fix items for you. We anticipate this challenge to continue for the foreseeable future. Fortunately, Fairlawn had some parts stocked ahead and we have an amazingly talented and creative maintenance team. We are concerned as we move forward that there may be delays. We want to assure you that Fairlawn is working diligently to secure needed supplies and to serve you as quickly as possible.
